Training Facilities

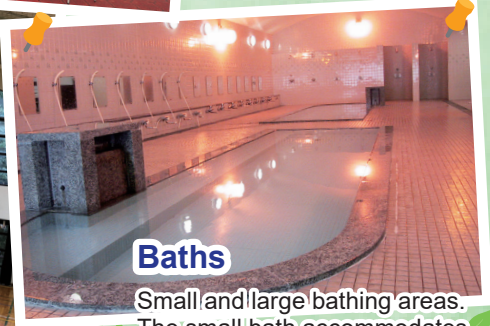
Play Hall

Standalone accommodation buildings. Each can accommodate approximately 40 guests.



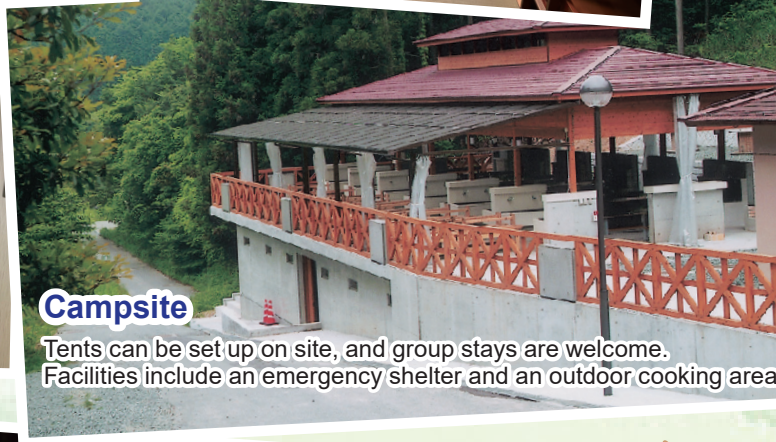
Dream B
